Chappell Hill Lavender Farm

We will visit an aromatic lavender farm with quaint surroundings and a scenic hillside view. The farm is about 8 miles north of the historic town of Chappell Hill, just off of the Texas Independence Trail. The farm has 23 rolling acres, 3-4 of which are dedicated to growing lavender. There are two primary varieties grown with the two blooming seasons. Most of the products in the gift shop are handmade here on the farm. Many local craftspeople also sell their wares in the gift shop.

During the cutting season, which occurs twice a year, you can casually stroll the fragrant rows and cut your own lavender. Provence lavender is cut in August & September. I hope to be there when they are cutting it, which depends on the crop this year.

They are open from 10:00 AM - 2:00 PM. After touring the Lavender Farm, we will eat lunch.

We will meet to carpool in the parking lot behind Salt Grass Steakhouse at Hwy 59 & 99 at 8:20 AM on Aug. 28th.

*Keep an eye on lawns to spot problems early and treat accordingly. Insects such as chinch bugs (treat with EcoSmart granules or diatomaceous earth) and fungi such as grey leaf spot (treat with Actino-Iron) are two things to watch out for.

*Hummingbirds are here!! Migrating hummingbirds can be found at your feeders and natural nectar sources. Keeping feeders clean, filled and in a shady area will encourage visitors. Recipe for Nectar:

- Bring 4 cups of water to a boil, add 1 cup of granulated sugar, stir until dissolve
- Allow to cool, fill feeders. Keep excess sealed in refrigerator.

*For preparing fall gardens, top dress with 2-4" of organic matter: compost like Ladybug Revitalizer and The Ground Up Vegan Compost are great choices. A layer of pine straw will keep weeds at bay until seeds or transplants have been placed.

*Continue slow, deep watering to encourage proper root growth and prevent runoff. Watering longer and less often encourages deep root growth and healthier plants. Soaker hoses or a regular hose turned on to a slow drip are good ways to do this.

*Mulch, mulch, mulch. Mulching keeps plant roots cooler and weed seeds at bay. Apply 3" deep around trees and shrubs. Remember: never pile mulch against the base of a plant.

*Check hibiscus for mealybugs and scale. Remove infested foliage. Treat as needed. Apply fish emulsion.

- *Prune deadwood from trees. It's hurricane season.
- *Trim roses and fertilize.
- *Transplant tomatoes as soon as possible.
- *Prune oleanders in late August or early September if needed.
- *Transplant Louisiana iris mid-August through September.


